Dear Customer,

European Directive 2011/65/EU, named RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances), defines restriction on use of dangerous substances in AEE electrical equipment, in order to guarantee to Men a greater degree of protection and to Environment a minor impact and possibility to recycle.

In particular, a maximum concentration of 0.1% of the weight of Lead, Mercury and Hexavalent Chromium and of 0.01% by weight of Cadmium is tolerated.

Euro Sider Scalo sells steels which respect the above limits and those that are included in Applications exempted, indicated in Annex III of above-mentioned Directive (particularly all grades of steel which contain "Lead as an alloying element in steel for machining purposes and in galvanised steel containing up to 0.35 % lead by weight") and therefore they have to be considered fully compliant to Directive RoHS.
